12. (a) Consider online reservation system for a library. With any two UML diagrams, model your information system. Justify the reasons for the diagrams you have chosen for the same.

- (b) List the various ways through which an information system can be analyzed and designed. Compare and contrast any two methods of your own choice.

13. (a) Explain DBMS, RDBMS. Bring out the differences between the two. Explain the advantages and features of both. Which one will be your preference to design an information system? Justify.

16. (a) Assume a school offers "Community School" classes after school hours. The majority of the programs are adult continuing education such as computer courses, personal finance, ballroom dancing, yoga, and photography. The director of these programs is having a hard time getting the recordkeeping done. Most of the records and course matching is done using spreadsheets. A modernization effort is underway, which includes building integrated application and database systems to perform basic business functions. The director has asked for your team to provide him with a functional system model and design with commentary about potential issues that could arise with the system. Considering the scenario, answer the following :

- (a) Model the information systems with DFD. (10)
(b) Explain the security mechanisms you would provide to keep data safe. (5)

(a) Model the information system with an ER diagram. (10)
(b) Analyze the ways through which the data mining approach would help the director in this information system. (5)
