
ENGINEERS DAY CELEBRATION



NAVARATHRI FESTIVAL




Practical demonstration of Surveying

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


Winners are awarded with prizes



A movie titled "WALL "E" was screened on 28.8.22 for the II and IV year students to motivate the students positively and make them focus on their dreams .









