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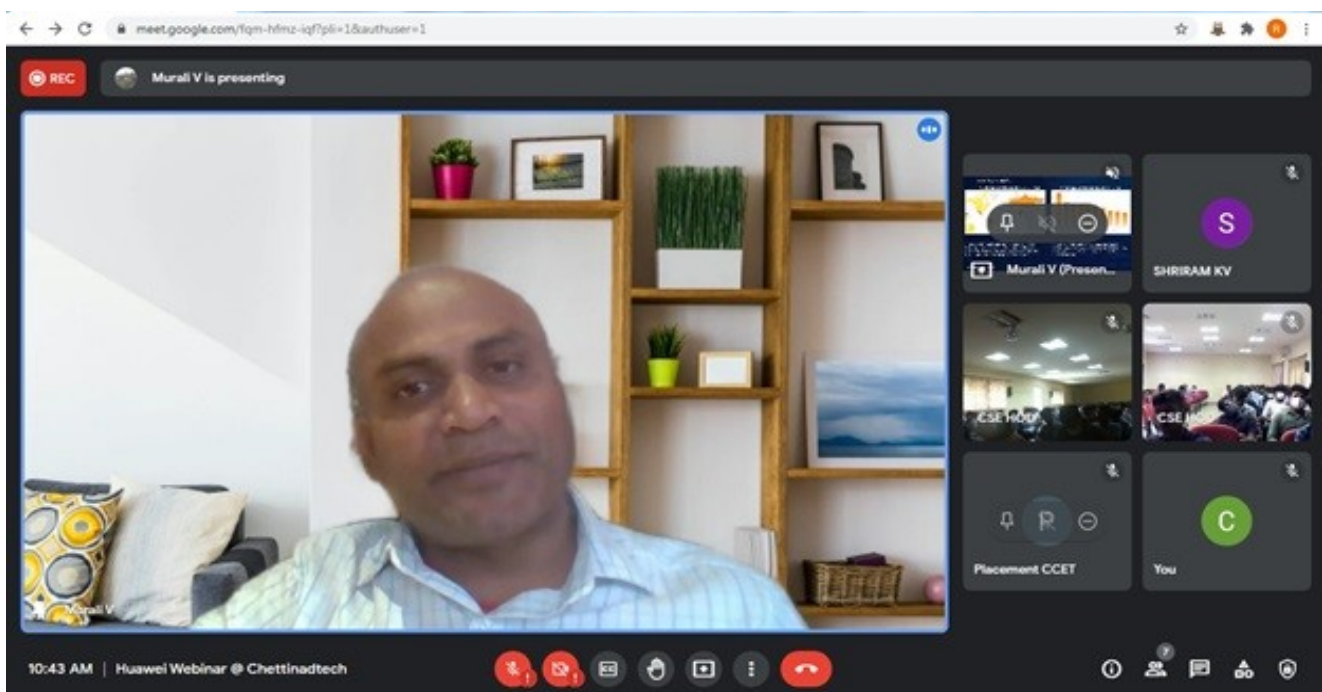
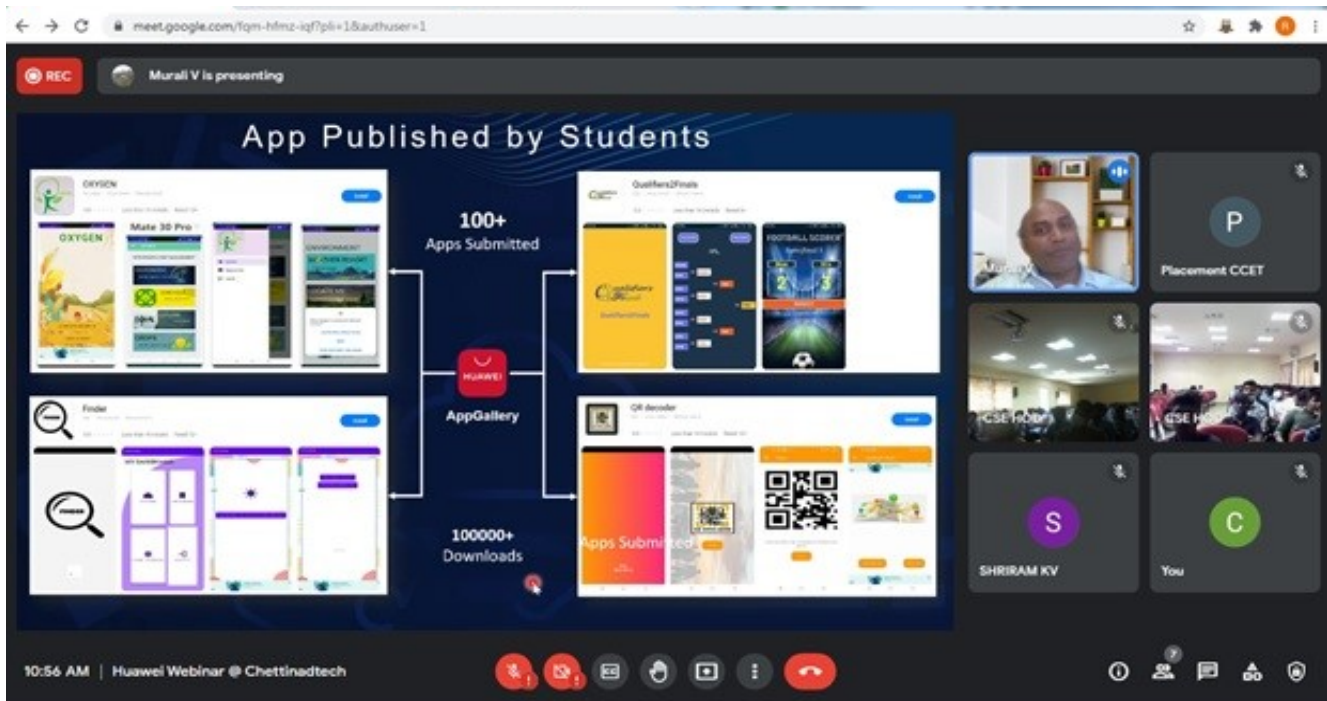
DEPARTMENT OF ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONICS ENGINEERING

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QUALITY CIRCLE TIME

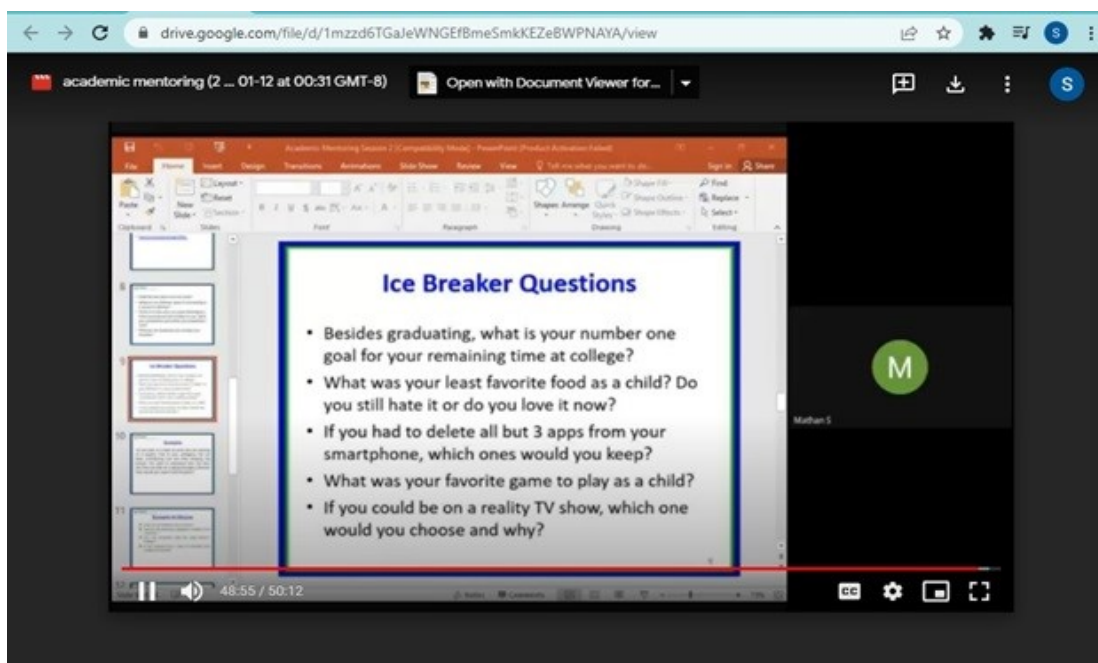

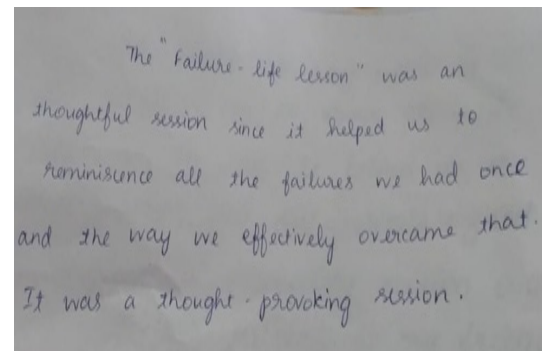
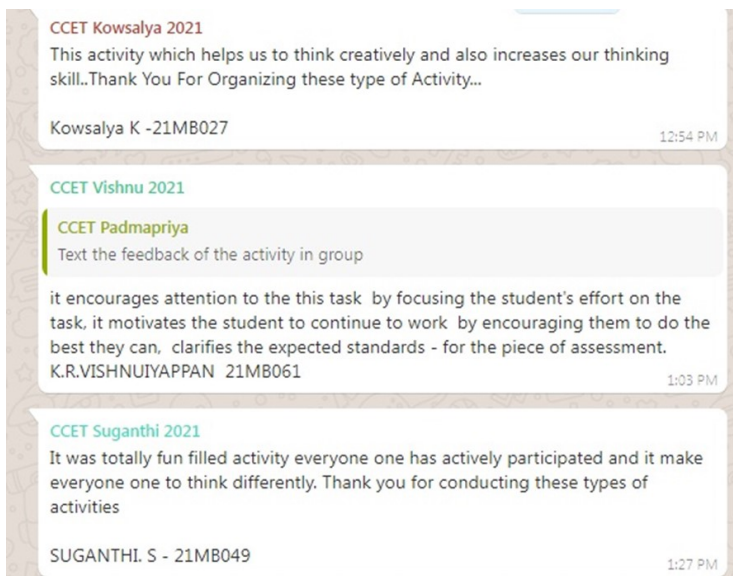
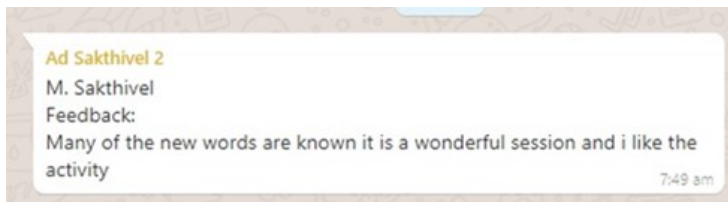
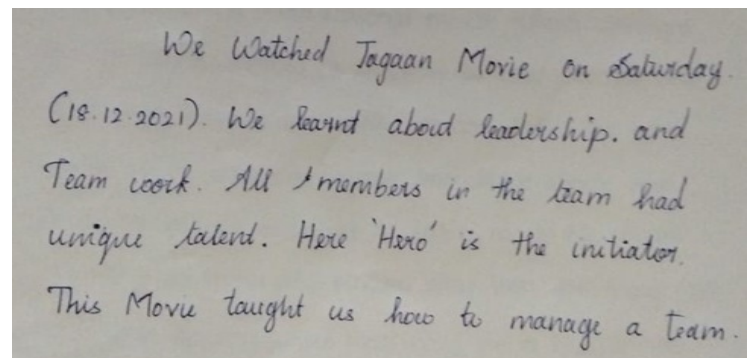
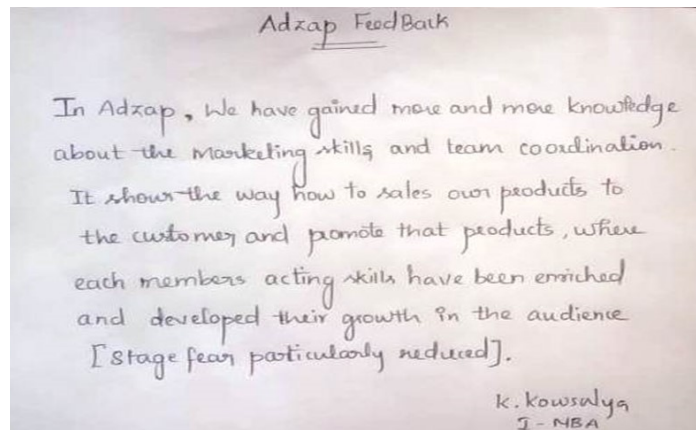
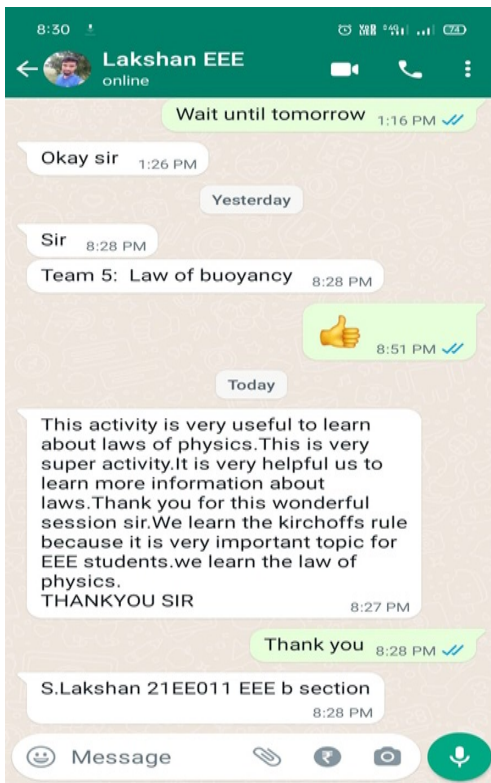


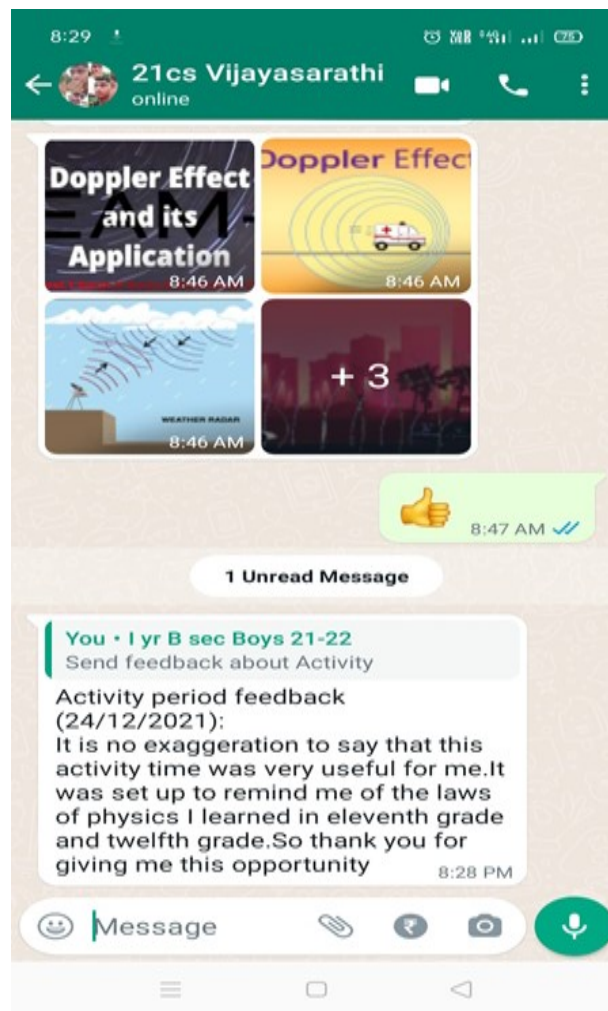
ACADEMIC MENTORING
