
DEPARTMENT OF ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONICS ENGINEERING





The major goal of the energy audit is to gather and evaluate data, calculate the amount of energy consumption, and implement workable and accepted remedies. Evaluating energy consumption is the first step for engineers to take, when trying to reduce energy consumption. So, students measured the medical facility electrical equipment power rating and estimated how much energy was utilised by each equipment and submitted the audit report.
