## **OUTLOOK - ICARE AWARD**







# DEPARTMENT OF COMPUTER SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING



# DEPARTMENT OF ELECTRONIC AND COMMUNICATION ENGINEERING



The webinar gave enough input on the present challenges faced in the power grid sector. The webinar was attended by more than 100 active participants.









### **Extracurricular and Co-Curricular Activities**



The department of civil conducted online circle time activities, like know thyself, object finding, every week by their mentors. The mentees participated enthusiastically in all events.












#### **Department of ECE**



## **Department of Mechanical Engineering**


The Department of Mechanical Engineering conducted various activities like smart techniques, discussion on hard work vs. smart work, career goal setting, to energise the students.






### **Department of EEE**

The Department of EEE conducted various cocurricular activities like build a circuit, Circuit Debugging, identification of symbols, technical talk, Brainstorming.








### **Department of CSE**


#### Co-curricular activities




Mechanical students' feedback on "Identification of Hydro-Pneumatic Symbols".

NSS Day was celebrated in the college campus on 24th of September by creating awareness to the public on Covid19 and distributed kabasura kudineer and facemask to the needy.


