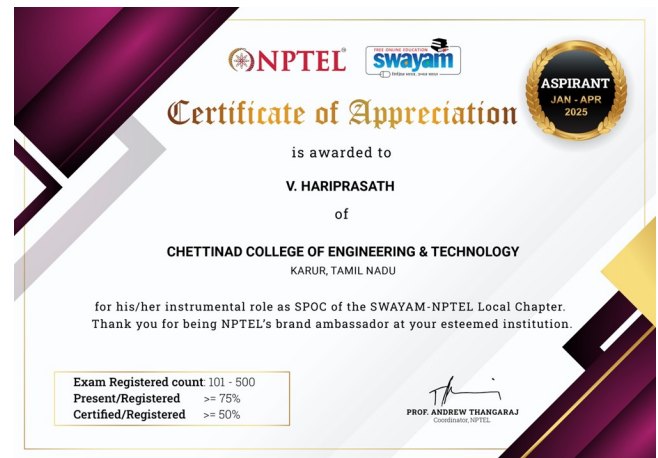
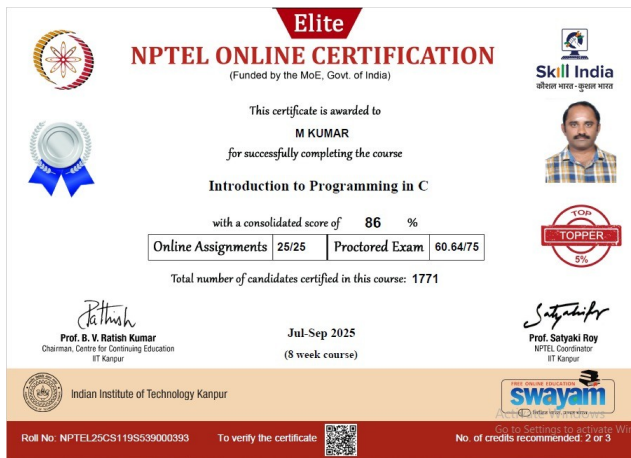

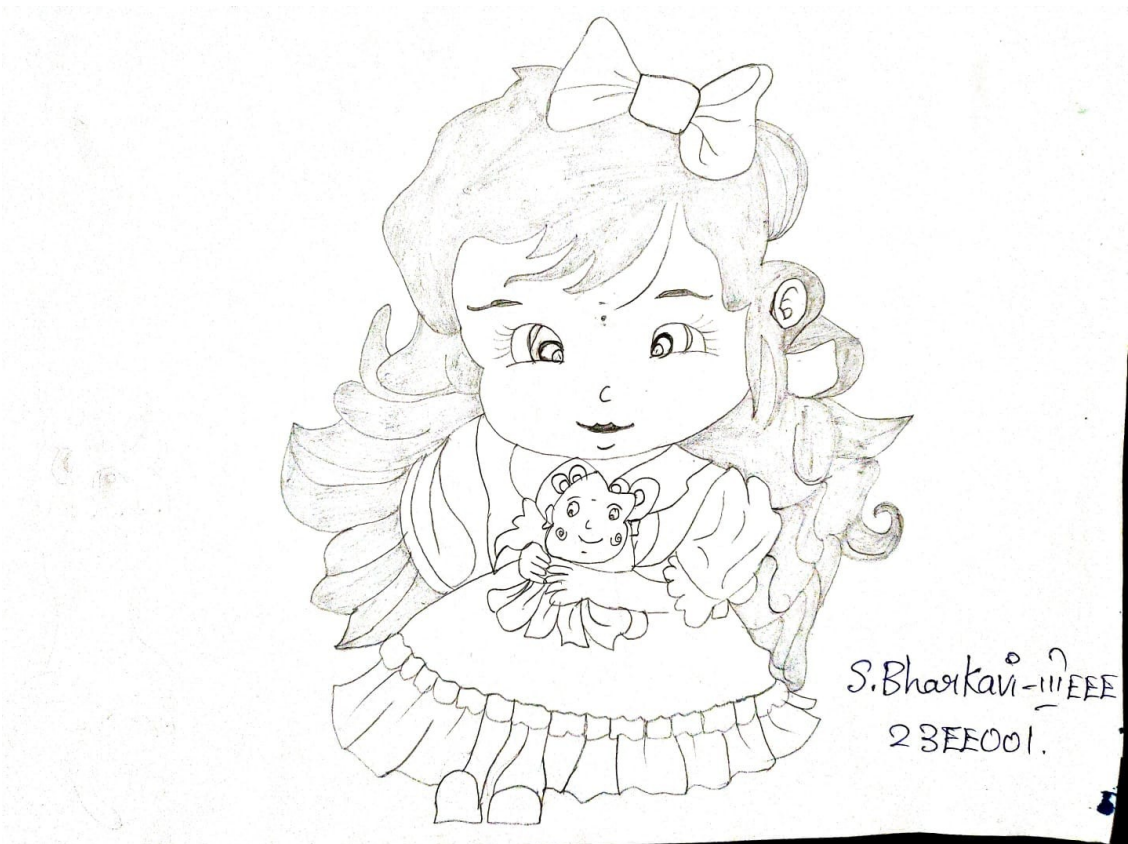
Highest Star Status by the MoE, Govt of India
