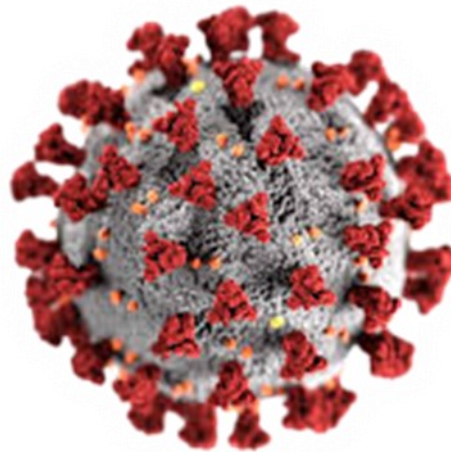




COVID'19 – UNLOCK SCENARIO IN CHETTINADTECH CAMPUS





As per the guidelines of the Central and State Governments, Chettinad College of Engineering and Technology has reopened after the lockdown for final year UG and PG students.

The college administration is taking all necessary steps to ensure the safety of students and staff members. Two committees, 'Students Safety Committee' and 'Campus Monitoring Committee' were set up with our college professors as members. According to their reports, the following actions have been taken.



Online Orientation on 'Safety Ethics for Students and Teachers' was given to staff members and students. Security rehearsals were then held on the college campus.



Prior to re-opening, the college campus and dormitory were disinfected. Students and staff members who use the college vehicles are advised to wear masks, disinfect and wash their hands before boarding the college bus. Vehicles of teachers and students are disinfected at the entry point into the campus.

Students are given disinfectant at the entrance of the hostel and their body temperature is monitored at regular intervals.





Seats in the classrooms and labs are set up keeping in view the norms of social distancing. Students and teachers are allowed inside the college campus only after their body temperature is checked, hands disinfected and making sure they wear masks.



Disinfectant liquids are placed at various places on the college campus so that students can clean their hands frequently.





Students are constantly instructed on safety measures to be taken during this period and notices regarding the same are posted on the college notice boards.

All toilets in the college and hostel are cleaned at regular intervals and disinfected.

Blood oxygen levels for teachers and students are checked at regular intervals.

A team of professors and hostel wardens are ready to assist students in case of any change in their physical condition after coming to the college.
